
Vinh Long

A province renowned for its extensive network of waterways and floating markets.

Vinh Long is one of 15 A&T project sites in Viet Nam. Covering an expanse of 1,496 square kilometers, the province has many small rivers and channels, creating a number of difficult-to-reach islands. In 2011, Vinh Long had a population of about one million people. Approximately 69,900 children are under five years of age and 28,800 children under two years of age. The poverty rate of this province is 9.2% (*compared to the national poverty rate of 12.9% in 2011*)¹.

The Vinh Long Department of Health has partnered with A&T to achieve the following objectives:

- Raise the rate of exclusive breastfeeding of infants under six months to 20% by 2014
- Improve the quality and quantity of complementary foods
- Reduce stunting by 1.5 percentage points each year

A&T's activities were implemented in Vinh Long city and three other district in Vinh Loong.

Mặt Trời Bé Thơ franchise model. This model is implemented in Vinh Long city and three of Vinh Long's eight districts in collaboration with health agencies at all levels. The first franchise was launched in May 2010, and by 2012 there were 45 Mặt Trời Bé Thơ franchises across the province. In 2014, an additional 21 franchises were established as part of the scaling-up process, bringing the total to 66 franchises. As of September 2014, a total of 146,000 counseling contacts have been delivered in Vinh Long, with a coverage rate of 98% in commune franchises. In September 2014, there were an average of 158 contacts in the network of franchises, of which 85% were repeat clients. The Vinh Long Department of Health is committed to supporting the operation of the franchises after the culmination of the project in 2015.

Results. A&T survey data indicate that from 2011 to 2014, the percentage of children who are breastfed early within the first hour decresed from 55% to 41% from baseline to endline. There was a significant rise in the percentage of children under six months who were exclusively breastfed and who continued to be breastfed until two years, from 15% to 60% and 8% to 29% respectively. There was also an increase in the minimun acceptable diet from 51% to 79%, and the minimum dietary diversity 72% to 92%. However, in the same period, the percentage of stunted children under the age of two also increased from 12.2% to 6.2%.
