The southernmost of Viet Nam's provinces, located on the Mekong Delta.

Alive & Thrive (A&T) is an initiative to improve infant and young child feeding (IYCF) practices by increasing rates of exclusive breastfeeding and improving complementary feeding practices. A&T aims to reach more than 16 million children under two years old in Bangladesh, Ethiopia and Viet Nam, and to create program models that can be replicated worldwide. In Viet Nam, A&T worked with the Ministry of Health, the National Institute of Nutrition (NIN), the Women's Union, the Viet Nam General Confederation of Labor (VGCL) and provincial authorities to double the rate of exclusive breastfeeding, improve the quality and quantity of complementary foods, and reduce stunting by two percentage points each year. These objectives were attained through different strategies including policy engagement, interpersonal counseling delivered through two distinct service delivery platforms, use of mass media, and the strategic use of data

Ca Mau is one of 15 A&T project sites in Viet Nam. Surrounded by the sea, fishing is an important industry in Ca Mau. Ca Mau is also a famous tourist destination. The province has a population of approximately 1.2 million. About 83,500 children are under five years of age and 34,300 children under two years of age. The poverty rate is 10.9% (compared to the national poverty rate of 12.9% in 2011)¹.

The Ca Mau Department of Health has partnered with A&T to achieve the following objectives:

- Double the rate of exclusive breastfeeding of infants under six months
- Improve the quality and quantity of complementary foods
- Reduce stunting by 2 percentage points each year

A&T activities are implemented in Ca Mau city and two of nine districts of Ca Mau Province.

Mặt Trời Bé Thơ franchise model. This model is implemented in Ca Mau city and the Dam Doi and Cai Nuoc districts in collaboration with health agencies at all levels. The first franchise was launched in July 2011, and by 2012 there were a total of 30 Mặt Trời Bé Thơ franchises across the province. In 2014, an additional 19 franchises were established as part of the scaling-up process, bringing the total to 49 franchises. As of September 2014, a total of 134,000 contacts have been delivered through the franchises with a coverage rate of 92%. In September 2014, an average of 216 clients visited the network of franchises, of which 84% were repeat clients. The Ca Mau Department of Health is committed to supporting the operation of the franchises after the culmination of the project in 2015.

IYCF support group model. This model is implemented in eight communes across Dam Doi and Cai Nuoc districts. There are a total of 30 villages with IYCF support groups. These groups are comprised of pregnant women, mothers and caregivers with children 0–24 months old living in remote areas.

Breastfeeding support in hospital. Ca Mau is one of four provinces that has approved the breastfeeding support in hospital guideline. The Ca Mau Department of Health issued an official guideline to support skin-to-skin contact and the early initiation of breastfeeding in all hospitals in the province. So far the guideline have been applied to 50-70% of cases of vaginal deliveries.

Workplace Program. In 2012, A&T collaborated with the Viet Nam General Confederation of Labor to establish two lactation rooms in Ca Mau, meeting the needs of about 1,050 female workers.

Results. A&T survey data indicate that from 2011 to 2014, the percentage of children who are breastfed early within the first hour increased from 41% to 61%. There was a significant rise in the percentage of children under six months who were exclusively breastfed, from 7% to 70%. However, there was a slight decrease in the rate of children who continue breastfeeding until two. A notable increase in indicators of minimum dietary diversity and minimum acceptable diet were observed. In the same period, the percentage of stunted and underweight children under the age of two declined from 15.1% to 9.9% and 9.2% to 8.8% respectively.
