Thai Nguyen

A multi-ethnic society with significant opportunities for industrial development.



Alive & Thrive (A&T) is an initiative to improve infant and young child feeding (IYCF) practices by increasing rates of exclusive breastfeeding and improving complementary feeding practices. A&T aims to reach more than 16 million children under two years old in Bangladesh, Ethiopia and Viet Nam, and to create program models that can be replicated worldwide. In Viet Nam, A&T worked with the Ministry of Health, the National *Institute of Nutrition (NIN), the* Women's Union, the Viet Nam General Confederation of Labor (VGCL) and provincial authorities to double the rate of exclusive breastfeeding, improve the quality and quantity of complementary foods, and reduce stunting by two percentage points each year. These objectives were attained through different strategies including policy engagement, interpersonal counseling delivered through two distinct service delivery platforms, use of mass media, and the strategic use of data

Thai Nguyen is one of 15 A&T project sites in Viet Nam. Located in the northern mountainous area, Thai Nguyen is blessed with abundant natural resources and considered the gateway for socio-economic development in the Red River Delta. Thai Nguyen has a population of approximately 1.2 million people. About 97,900 children are under five years of age and 40,200 children under two years of age. The poverty rate is 16.9% (compared to the national poverty rate of 12.9% in 2011).

The Thai Nguyen Department of Health has partnered with A&T to achieve the following objectives:

- Double the rate of exclusive breastfeeding of infants under six months
- Improve the quality and quantity of complementary foods
- Reduce stunting by 1.5 percentage points each year

A&T's activities were implemented in 3 districts.

Mặt Trời Bé Thơ franchise model. This model is implemented in three of Thai Nguyen's nine districts in collaboration with health agencies at all levels. The first franchise was launched in August 2011, and by 2012 there were 51 Mặt Trời Bé Thơ franchises across the province. In 2014, an additional 13 franchises were established as part of the scaling-up process, bringing the total to 64 franchises. As of September 2014, a total of 121,000 counseling contacts have been delivered in Hanoi, with a coverage rate of 86% in commune franchises. In September 2014, there were an average of 110 contacts in the network of franchises, of which 83% were repeat clients. The Thai Nguyen Department of Health is committed to integrating the operation of the Mặt Trời Bé Thơ franchises into the National Program on Nutrition to sustain the model after the culmination of the project in 2015.

Results. A&T survey data indicate that from 2011 to 2014, the percentage of children who are breastfed early within the first hour did not increase between the baseline and endline. There was a significant rise in the percentage of children under six months who were exclusively breastfed from 30% to 69%, and a slight increase in those who continued to be breastfed until two years, from 14% to 15%. There was also an increase in the minimum acceptable diet (66% to 82%), and the minimum dietary diversity, from 82% to 90%. In the same period, the percentage of stunted children under the age of two also decreased from 13.6% to 12%.
