# Quang Tri

A small and poor province reflecting Viet Nam's diverse geography and population

Alive & Thrive (A&T) is an initiative to improve infant and young child feeding (IYCF) practices by increasing rates of exclusive breastfeeding and improving complementary feeding practices. A&T aims to reach more than 16 million children under two years old in Bangladesh, Ethiopia and Viet Nam, and to create program models that can be replicated worldwide. In Viet Nam, A&T worked with the Ministry of Health. the National Institute of Nutrition (NIN), the Women's Union, the Viet Nam General Confederation of Labor (VGCL) and provincial authorities to double the rate of exclusive breastfeeding, improve the quality and quantity of complementary foods, and reduce stunting by two percentage points each year. These objectives were attained through different strategies including policy engagement, interpersonal counseling delivered through two distinct service delivery platforms, use of mass media, and the strategic use of data

Quang Tri is one of 15 A&T project sites in Viet Nam. The province has harsh weather and is poverty stricken as a result of the Viet Nam War. The poverty rate is 21.7% (*compared to the national poverty rate of 12.9% in 2011*)<sup>1</sup>. Quang Tri has a population of approximately 601,800 people. About 52,900 children are under five years of age and 21,700 children under two years of age.

The Quang Tri Department of Health has partnered with A&T to achieve the following objectives:

- Double the rate of exclusive breastfeeding of infants under six months
- Improve the quality and quantity of complementary foods
- Reduce stunting by 2 percentage points each year

**Mặt Trời Bé Thơ franchise model.** This model is implemented in four of Quang Tri's nine districts in collaboration with health agencies at all levels. The first franchise was launched in August 2011 at Dong Ha Health Center, and by 2012 there were 25 Mặt Trời Bé Thơ franchises across the province. As of September 2014, a total of 66,000 counseling contacts have been delivered in Quang Tri and the coverage rate is 88% in commune franchises. In September 2014, 2,900 clients visited the network of franchises, of which 100% were repeat clients. In 2014, an additional five franchises were established as part of the scaling-up process, bringing the total to 30 franchises. The Quang Tri Department of Health is committed to supporting the operation of the franchises after the culmination of the project in 2015.

**IYCF support group model.** This model is implemented in 10 communes in two districts of Gio Linh and Huong Hoa. IYCF support groups have been established in 31 villages. These groups are comprised of pregnant mothers and caregivers with children 0–24 months of age living in remote areas. As of September 2014, the cumulative number of counseling contacts was 17,900.

**Results**. A&T survey data indicate that from 2011 to 2014, the percentage of children who are breastfed early within the first hour increased from 73% to 80%. There was a significant rise in the percentage of children under six months who were exclusively breastfed, from 21% to 62%. There was also a marginal increase in the percentage of children receiving a minimum acceptable diet (77% to 82%) and in the minimum meal frequency (94% to 97%). The percentage of stunted children under the age of two declined, from 18.3% to 11.4%.
